Dear Coroner:

As you know, Illinois county coroners and medical examiners are authorized to inquire about potential organ/tissue donors who are listed in the Illinois Secretary of State's Organ/Tissue Donor Registry. While the First Person Consent law no longer requires family approval for a person to become an organ/tissue donor, in the unlikely case of a question or clarification, the Secretary of State Police Inquiry Unit (PIU) can be contacted for confirmation. The PIU maintains the information for the Secretary of State's Organ/Tissue Donor Registry. The PIU phone number for organ/tissue donor registry information is (800) 358-0238.

Since the organ/tissue donor registry is confidential, our office requires that each person authorized to receive information from the registry is listed on an official form. The form is provided to the PIU and if a person is not listed on the form, he or she cannot receive information about the donor.

Please fill out the form, print it, and send by fax or mail to the address listed below. If you are unable to access the form, please call the Secretary of State's Organ/Tissue Donor Section at (217) 782-6258 to request the form by mail.

If there are personnel changes within your agency, it is necessary to update and submit your lists and provide the information to the PIU. For tracking and security reasons, please DO NOT SEND the form directly to the Secretary of State Police.
