## **CONTEST RULES**

**The purpose of the contest is to promote public awareness of the importance of organ/tissue donation.**

- Complete the above entry form in full, cut and attach to the back of the poster.
- **DEADLINE:** All posters must be postmarked by **Jan. 31, 2020**, and sent to the Secretary of State's Organ/Tissue Donor Program at 501 S. 2nd St., Rm. 451 Howlett Bldg., Springfield, IL 62756-9000.
- Categories are as follows: Category 1: grades K-2; Category 2: grades 3-5; Category 3: grades 6-8; and Category 4: grades 9-12.
- Artwork **must** be submitted without folding or bending. Preferred size: 11" x 14" on poster board.
- Artwork may be created in crayon, ink, paint, colored pencil or markers. (Posters with chalk, oil, glitter or lamination will not be accepted because they are difficult to reproduce.)
- Artwork must be original and hand drawn. No computer aided designs or graphics will be accepted.
- Do not use copyrighted characters (Batman, Toy Story, Moana, Frozen, etc.).
- All slogans should support organ/tissue donation in general. **Do not limit slogans to one specific organ or tissue.**
- **Posters will be judged on readability, general design, creativity and message.**
- All posters become the property of the Illinois Secretary of State and may be reproduced.
