Vanity/Personalized Plates

- No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after a plate has been ordered or if the request form is incorrectly completed.
- The Secretary of State's office is authorized to recall a plate determined to be obscene or offensive.
- All request forms should indicate whether or not you want the Secretary of State to assign one of your choices with the next available number if your exact request is unavailable.
- If you wish to submit more than three requests, attach additional selections to the request form.

DO NOT

- Intermix letters and numbers
- Use a space between numbers
- Use lowercase letters
- Use characters, symbols, foreign words or symbols of punctuation, such as dashes or periods
- Select obscene or offensive combinations

First-Time Registrations

- Money must accompany request forms on all first-time registrations.
- A leased vehicle is eligible for vanity or personalized plates.

- Visit any Driver Services facility and say "yes" to the donor question.
- Complete and mail the registration card on the donor brochure.

If you have not signed up for the registry since January 2006, you must re-register.

Registration and Fee Information

Organ/Tissue Donor License Plates are multi-year and may be displayed on passenger vehicles, B-trucks and vans weighing 8,000 pounds or less.

To purchase Organ/Tissue Donor plates, please submit the appropriate request form along with your license plates registration or renewal application and the following applicable fees:

(\$101 registration fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Current plates do not expire within 90 days — \$54
(\$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Annual renewal — \$126
(\$101 registration fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee)

(\$101 registration fee, \$94 vanity fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee)
- Current plates expire within 90 days — \$249
(\$101 registration fee, \$94 vanity fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Current plates do not expire within 90 days — \$148
(\$94 vanity fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Annual renewal — \$139
(\$101 registration fee, \$13 vanity fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee)

- Current plates expire within 90 days — \$202
(\$101 registration fee, \$47 personalized fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Current plates do not expire within 90 days — \$101
(\$47 personalized fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee, \$29 replacement fee)
- Annual renewal — \$133
(\$101 registration fee, \$7 personalized fee, \$25 Organ/Tissue Donor plate fee)
